



POLINAS TEAR TAPE USER'S MANUAL

A- CONTROL BY ARRIVAL

If there is any damage or visible deformation on POLINAS tear tape cases, a report should be prepared and signed by the transporter and customer. The report should be sent to POLINAS immediately together with photos.

B- WAREHOUSING CONDITIONS

- The storage area should be at 05-35°C, reels should not be subject to direct sunlight. Shelf life is 1 year from production date if the reels are stored according to these conditions.
- During the warehousing period, tear tapes should be kept in their original cases which will prevent dust, strike or moisture.
- Maximum stacking height is 6 cases and bottom cases may be damaged if maximum stacking height is exceeded.

C- USE IN PACKAGING MACHINE

- It is recommended to bring the reels to the production environment 24 hours in prior to using.
- To stick the tear tape on film, it is sufficient that the tear tape contacts film with little pressure.
- In case of any break, it is recommended that the broken part should be tied by hand instead of cutting with a knife.
- If the rolls where the tear tapes pass are teflon, glue accumulation problem will be minimized. The glue accumulated can be cleaned by alcohol.

D- COMPLAINTS

In case of any problem, POLINAS should be notified together with description of problem, photo and sample. This will help to keep track of complaints and avoid them in the future.
